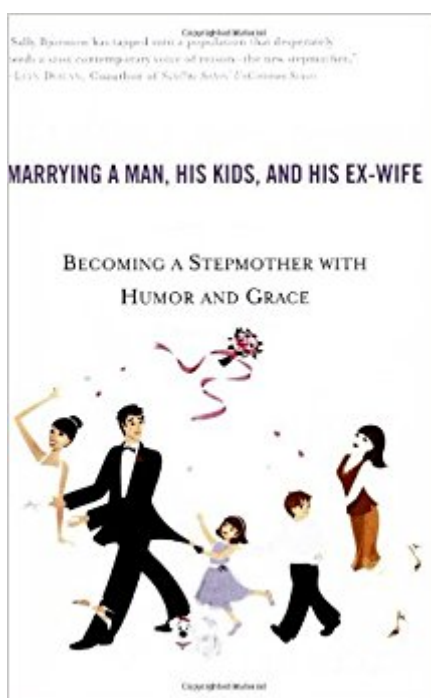

I have read this book three times over. I turn to it when I start taking myself and my situation too seriously. My story is much more tumultuous than Sally's (I have four young stepchildren, a PEW, and a new business of my own complete with relocation), but I relate on so many levels. These stories have gotten me through some tough times with laughter and logic. If you are single without children of your own, think of yourself as intelligent and of a good sense of humor, and thinking of

marrying a guy who already has a family from a previous marriage you owe it to yourself to give this book a chance. It will teach you so much more about what you owe to yourself and then some.

It is a wonderful book! We met whilst my man still was married and on top of the ex- and 2 toddlers, I had to deal with the separation stress, a divorce, confused children and a fight for half of their custody. Before that book I had almost 0 idea how to behave and I'm very grateful to the author as her advice and guidance enabled me to create some balance and happiness in our household even though we were in the middle of a war zone.

YES. This needs to be a staple in every stepmom's reading list...30 pages in I felt so relieved that I wasn't the only woman feeling this way. The book does an excellent job of explaining real-life experiences and being honest about (very much relatable) situations and feelings. It put a lot into perspective for me. I understood bio-mom much better (even though she would be categorized as "psycho" according to the author's description) and it made me reflect on how my actions are perceived by my man and my step kids. Stepmom-ing is hard, don't make it harder on yourself by feeling isolated or alone in your struggles. Easy read, good lessons.

This book is a **MUST** read for stepmoms and anyone in a stepmom-type role. Not only does this book flesh out a lot of the obstacles most of us will/have hit, it does so with humor (much appreciated!). I laughed out loud several times while reading :-)- I disagree with other reviewers that this book is corny or creepy, I think it is very funny, well-written, and frankly, **TRUE**. But what I most appreciate are the exercises/examples at the end of each chapter that help us to prepare and deal with a lot of the difficulties that come with being a stepmom. After laying out the problem, and helping us to vent (needed!!!), the author helps us to positively deal and be proactive about improving the situation. **THAT** is what helps us get through the challenge of being a stepmom! That is what makes this book so useful.

I'm in this situation and this is by far the most helpful book I've ever read. It's a very different becoming a stepmother when you've already been a biological mother, versus becoming a stepmother when you've been a single girl most of your life. This book is filled with humor, great advice, and the comorbidity of reading people's stories he's been in a similar situation is so comforting. Highly recommended.
