I bought a set of these to include in a unit on non-fiction text features for my Kindergarten/First Grade class. This book is perfect for several reasons. It is written at a level where early readers can do a lot of the reading themselves and use their decoding strategies to successfully problem solve unfamiliar words. Subject matter captivated their attention and helped underscore importance/use of many of the features we have discussed, i.e. contents page, photos, captions, charts, map, glossary, index. Just wish it showed better examples of labels, but that would make this book beyond perfect. Did I mention that I love this book? :)

I bought this book for my 2 year old son. It has awesome photos, which you can always expect from National Geographic, and great information. I must admit that while introducing this book to my son, I realized just how little I actually know about the animal kingdom. It's a great book for kids and adults too!

I have to say that all the books in the Kids First Big Book series are amazing. These have true National Geographic quality images, some snippets about the animals that small kids can understand/ remember and decent quality paper capable of withstanding some rough handling. There is likely a little redundancy between this Big Book of Animals and the Big Book of Ocean, but it is only because the content is categorized by the various animal habitats (ocean being one of them). I would completely overlook this aspect if you are trying to get your little ones excited about other forms of life on earth. My 3 yr old and his nanny spend hours with this book on a regular basis.
