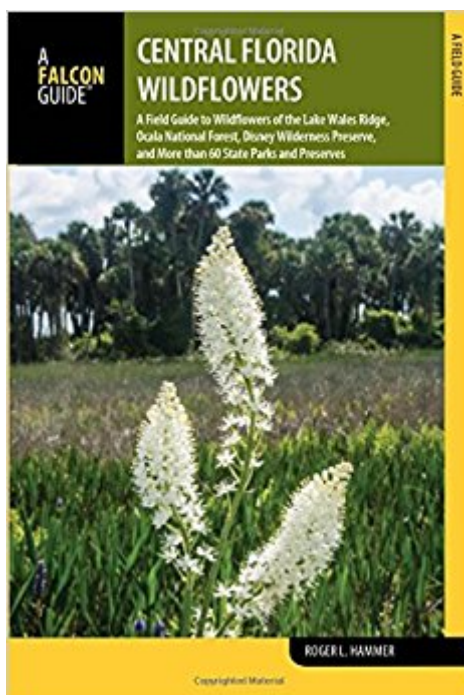

Since it was published in 2002, Roger Hammer's Everglades Wildflowers has been the gold standard for photographic wildflower guides for the southern half of Florida. Now comes his latest version of the guide, and if the first one was the gold standard, this one sets the platinum standard for such books for wildflower enthusiasts Florida Native Plant Society

Roger L. Hammer is a professional naturalist and a part-time instructor and fieldtrip leader for Fairchild Tropical Garden in Miami. He received the first Marjory Stoneman Douglas Award and the Charles Brookfield Medal. He lives in Homestead, Florida.

I see this as a must-have book, living on the Lake Wales Ridge and having an interest in wildflowers. The photographs are sharp and the flowers are organized in sections by color, which makes it a lot easier to ID something if you have no idea where to start. I have two criticisms, neither one a deal-breaker: (1) I would like to see more of the plant/leaves, in addition to the flower; and (2)

the index is alphabetized by the full common name, followed by the Latin name, so that you can find, for example, netted pawpaw under N, and bethany pawpaw under B, but nothing under Pawpaw. All in all, though, this is a great book to have for Central FL wildflowers.

I've bought several of Roger Hammer's books and field guides (including Everglades Wildflowers, and several of the laminated field guides), and am delighted with his latest book. Having it organized around the flower color gives me a starting point when identifying an unfamiliar wildflower. Having a concise description, along with bloom season and habitat, makes it easy to narrow down your identification. My copy of Everglades Wildflowers is battered and dog-eared from use -- looking forward to having this latest book equally well-used. (We've been on wildflower walks in the Everglades with Roger, and I can 'hear' his voice when I'm reading the comments, too.) I highly recommend this book to anyone interested in a deeper appreciation of Florida's natural beauty.

Roger Hammer of Homestead Florida has taken the lead in native flora field guides with this extremely fine publication. Never before have so many of central Florida's spectacular wildflowers been depicted and described in a single volume. This glossy-laminated field guide is the result of countless hours of planning and thousands of miles of travel, coupled with highly skilled photography, and backed by considerable scientific research. Approximately 381 native plants are presented, including many rare and endangered species, all in a beautiful, easy to find, and "simple to identify" format. Of special value to plant enthusiasts and botanists alike are the concise field descriptions, superb comments, detailed range data, and eloquent introductory narratives, all of which were meticulously formulated and framed based on the author's personal observations and experience. Most interesting is the etymology provided for each botanical and common plant name.

Every photo has been carefully composed to include information essential for accurate identification. The two words I have for this book are "Buy it!" [This review by Kris R.
