

Vaccines And Your Child: Separating Fact From Fiction





Synopsis

Paul A. Offit and Charlotte A. Moser answer questions about the science and safety of modern vaccines. In straightforward prose, they explain how vaccines work, how they are made, and how they are tested. Most important, they separate the real risks of vaccines from feared but unfounded risks. Offit and Moser address parental fears that children may receive too many vaccines too early, that the HPV vaccine may cause chronic fatigue or other dangerous side effects, that additives and preservatives in vaccines cause autism, and that vaccines might do more harm than good. There couldn't be a better moment or more pressing need for this book, which offers honesty—instead of hype—in the quest to protect children's health.

He has authored Autism's False Prophets; Vaccinated: One Man's Quest to Defeat the World's Deadliest Diseases; The Cutter Incident: How America's First Polio Vaccine Led to the Growing Vaccine Crisis; and Deadly Choices: How the Anti-Vaccine Movement Threatens Us All.Charlotte A. Moser is the assistant director of the Vaccine Education Center at The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia and creator of the center's program for parents, known as Parents PACK. She has developed a variety of educational materials about vaccines, oversees the center's Web content and contact center, and writes the monthly e-mail newsletter for Parents PACK, which has several thousand subscribers.

I have read several books about vaccines, and this is the best one so far . It addresses common areas of concerns for parents and nothing is sugar coated, it contains factual information and shares a few personal stories as well. Great resource!

I bought this and read it from cover to cover and this is definitely the book I am going to recommend to my patients' parents to read. It is the perfect antidote for the Sear's pseudoscience Vaccine book. Vaccines And You Child is scientifically sound, easy to read and trustworthy. An added benefit to getting the kindle edition is that web links take you to sites where you can hear the horrific whooping cough, get information from the CDC and many other pertinent links. Of note, since published, there is an updated recommendation about the meningococcal meningitis vaccine (Menactra). The book says it is a single dose series, but it recently has been recommended that children get two doses,

one at age 11 and a booster at age 16 (or 5 years after the first.). As always, check with your pediatrician for the latest and best information for your child.

This book is short and to the point. It covers all of the major questions that parents have on vaccines, and provides answers based on actual science. It does not sugar coat anything. It is by Dr Paul Offit- the world's expert on vaccines from the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia. He has other excellent books on this topic, which go into much more detail and history on everything, but those books are long. This book is designed for parents in bite-size chapters. It is not one sided, as another reviewer complained- it is based on scientific evidence. It is not Dr Offit's fault that scientific evidence has shown again and again that vaccinations are safe overall for the majority of children. If a new parent only has time to read one book, this is the book they should read!
