

With a much needed emphasis on the western scientific background, (and justification) for acupuncture, this helps to fill a void. While many will feel like they need more in-depth anatomical review than is offered, the emphasis on the neurobiological/neurophysiological basis for the effects seen with acupuncture provides an understanding that many trained in western human and veterinary medicine will find invaluable. The book is written in a highly readable format.
