There were some pretty funny jokes in here, but I noticed there was some overlap and some of the formatting was annoying or poorly done. However, my biggest frustration was the amount of sheer sexism in the book. One does expect a certain amount of playing on gender stereotypes for humor, but some of the jokes were so intensely misogynistic that I was frowning at the book rather than laughing.
