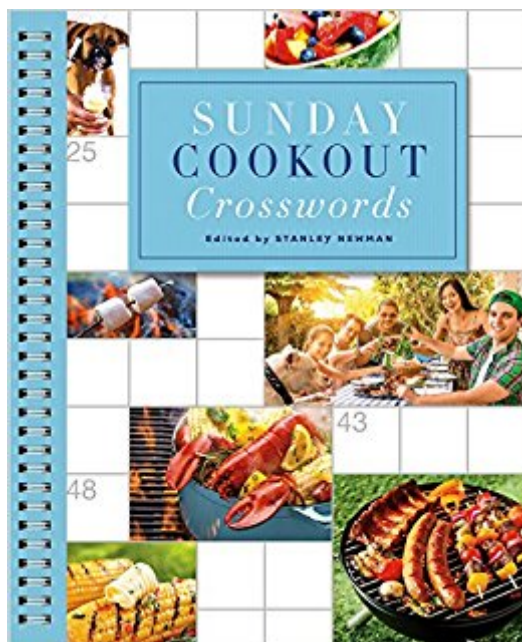

One of my pet peeves with many crossword puzzle books is their use of newsprint, which allows the ink to bleed onto the puzzle on the other side of the page you're working on. These nicely bound books use a superior stock, clay-coated, to prevent this bleed-through. More importantly, the puzzles themselves are great - not maddening like a NY Times Sunday crossword, but not exactly easy either.

Excellent collection for crossworders who enjoy a challenging but not obtuse set of clues. Book well-made, easy to read print; can't beat the price!

I enjoy this series of crossword puzzle books. They are hard enough for me without being too hard. The cues are big enough to see. The spiral bindings are convenient to use. I very much enjoy the little extrapolations on the answer page which define some interesting points of trivia.

I love this series, both the Billig and the Newman edited books. This one did run a little on the easy

to moderate side, but like all of them, it is well constructed, spiral bound, and large enough to be easily readable in proper light. I like that the paper doesn't bleed, as I'm one who likes to use roller-ball pens to do these. I like that these puzzles use wordplay, both in the clues and the themes, yet the clues tend to be contemporary and accessible, with a minimum of archaic language or minutia.

Very good book of puzzles. Just enough twists and turns to keep them interesting!

These type of crosswords are my favorite. Having the binder makes them easy to keep open when you're working on a puzzle & all of these puzzles are challenging.

Love the format which makes it easy to use. The puzzles are well done and make one think. Having the answers in the back is a real plus. I hate not being able to finish a puzzle and this happens sometimes.

Of the crossword books in this series, this is the easiest I've seen so far. It's fun, but less challenging than others, such as "Sunday Hammock Crosswords."
