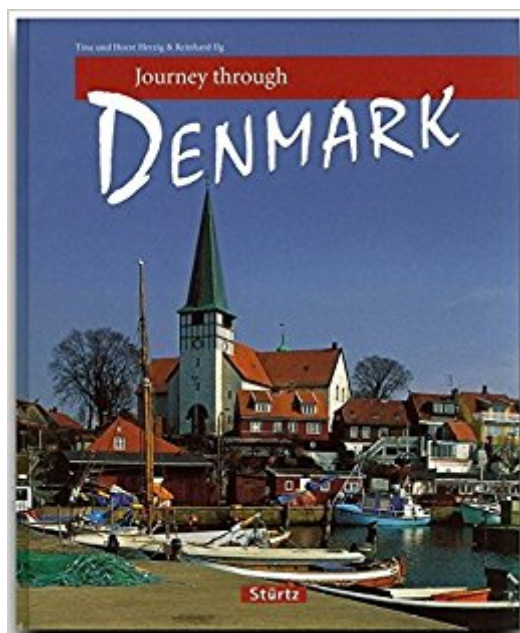

Journey Through Denmark represents an excellent review of a delightful country that continues to retain its old historic presence in the world coupled with its thoughtful voyage into the modern world. The charm of its villages and towns with their own unique personalities is highlighted superbly in

their descriptions and the references to their trying to keep up with the modern world quickly helps the reader place this country into a category that says: I really MUST visit this country!. The charm of Copenhagen and the other larger cities is well portrayed and the best part of the book is in the descriptions of the many small towns and villages that gives Denmark that "Fairyland" label. It is a book well worth owning and will never become outdated.

The book is a pretty good overview of Denmark. It has a wide variety of photos, including small towns, people in local costumes, food, and landscapes. The photos range in size from 4 photos to a page up to 1 photo that spans across 2 pages. The photo quality is above average. Each photo has a description of a few sentences. Overall the book is about 75% photos and about 25% text. Having seen a number of photo books about Denmark, this is definitely one of the better ones.
