Why only a 3-star review for what could truly be an excellent series? Read on. This is an excellent series. The concept stands out from the usual story lines in the genre. The fact that a male author is writing from a female perspective is also very well done. The characters are all very believable. The author's descriptions are well done and vivid. The stories themselves are all very compelling and generally keep the reader wanting more. It is truly a series that is hard to put down. The author suffers from one MAJOR FLAW, however. He is painfully in need of an editor. The numerous typographical errors are beyond the pale and incredibly distracting. There are even times in some of the later books where the names of the characters are wrong. There's simply no excuse for those kinds of errors when a good editor could correct them so very easily. What's worse is that, on the author's website, many readers have pointed out a variety of errors to the author. The author's response? He says he'll make corrections, but never does. There are suggestions made from 5 years ago that continue to be acknowledged and then ignored. Truly a pity from what could otherwise be a great series! But hey, if you don't mind a missing word here and there, or a few misspelled words, characters' names being confused with one another, but want to read a really great story, then by all means, this is a great series to choose.

The story itself is excellent, the characters are good and developed as much as needed to fit in with the plot. Story moves right along and can be tough to put down - all good things. Problem with this book is first of all it's a 3-book set not the 4 book set as it appears to be from the cover photo. The other problem with these earlier works by Jonathan Moeller is the editing is much worse than his current writings. Good news is most of those editing misses don't detract from the story too much - you can figure out what he's trying to say pretty quickly. Still, really need more proofreading on these.

I love to find these Omnibus collections of Moellers books at a good price. Its like getting Large fries and a drink at no extra charge, with out the fat going to your but. Great deal on a good story, and storyline

check was used, and no one read it over to be sure the correct words were used. It is easy to assume the intended language, but it is simply annoying.

Back to Caina's childhood and the pages behind a ghost have been a fabulous read. Highly recommend the whole series and reading it in the right order!

Jonathan Moeller has great books. All the main characters have strong yet humble personalities. He just needs a MUCH BETTER proof reader....misspelled words, missing words in sentences, words transposed in sentences. Even with all the grammatical errors, I still love his books
