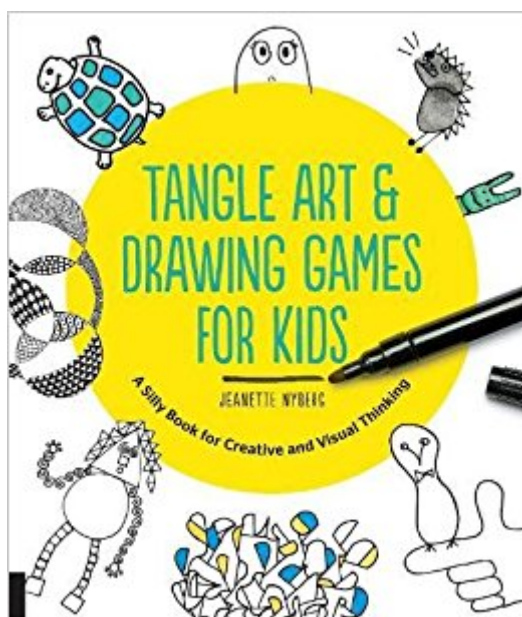

Apparently when I order another copy to use at work I should include one for my adult groups as well.
