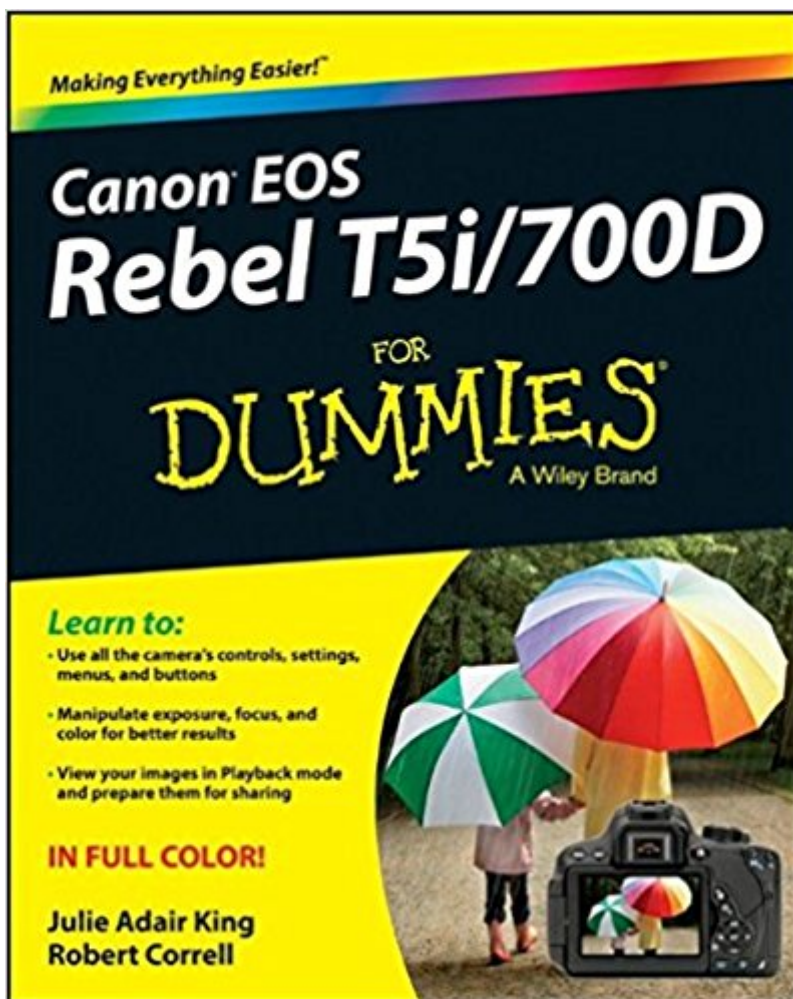

This is a great book if you really want to get to know your T5i Canon camera. Layout is thoughtful and each chapter can build on the last or can stand on its own. A definite buy if you are serious about taking great pics without relying on auto settings!

I bought this book along with my first dslr camera (t5i of course!). I read it within the first two days and am very pleased . Not only does it explain the workings of the t5i , but it is an excellent introduction to dslr photography . The principles and basics of the Optics involved in photography are explained very nicely . This has definitely inspired me into learning more about photography.

The book does a good job of explaining how you mechanically do things on the camera, but it does not go very much into photography technique. This is fair, since the book's subject is specifically the Canon Rebel T5i, but you'll need other books to add the PHOTOGRAPHY advice!

I bought and received this e-book (Kindle) before my camera arrived and very thoroughly studied it as I was moving up from a still photo only DSLR. I had a Rebel XTi and bought a T5i. Once I received the camera I read the manual which came with it. Frankly, the owner's manual was extremely well written, logical and intuitive in layout. Bottom line, the owner's manual was better for me than the Dummies book. And I can be quite the dummy. If you just feel that the joke-free, small format, non-margin noted Canon manual is too industrial for you then by all means get the one with the pictures. All the same information is there and it'll teach you what you want to know. It was of no extra benefit to me.

This is an awesome book! I just got my first DSLR camera and knew almost nothing about them. I am still working my way through the book but the instructions are very clear and the writers are concise and often witty (yes, I have laughed out loud at a camera instruction book - yikes). Even though I haven't finished the book I already feel very comfortable with my camera, its settings, and even the more advanced options.

I was not expecting this book to be as good as it is, last time I looked at one of these Dummies books it was one of their 1st, DOS FOR DUMMIES, and it was very basic black and white text on the standard paper used in most paper back of the time, very informative but bland presentation....HOWEVER, this book is printed on beautiful glossy paper with incredible color images and YES it is also still as informative as ALWAYS !Heaps of important tips etc even for an experienced photographer - EXCELLENT choice someone to really get up close and personal with their Canon EOS T5i/700D !

the complexities of the camera a lot and she's glad she's got it.
