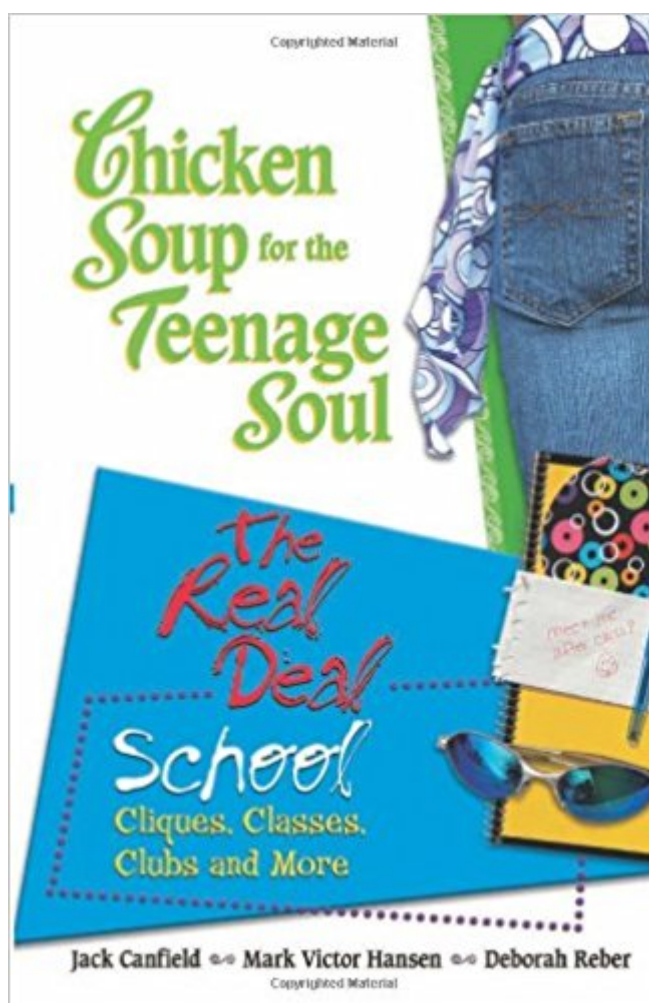

The stories and statistics are wonderful; however, the Kindle Fire version is not the best. There are typing errors, the print for the quiz answers is very small, and the boxes on the pages are all messed up. Also, the stories that the author tells us about being a teenager are not detailed enough and don't make sense to me. I don't think the author relates to modern day teens. Sometimes when I am reading a story and a box is in the middle of the text (to state a fact, give a quiz, etc.), I get annoyed because it interrupts my reading. On the bright side, I like what is inside of the little annoying boxes. I believe that the boxes are suppose to be colorful and whatever but they are not. Once again, this is a good book, but it is not the greatest.

My teenage granddaughter could not put this down. It is the first book in a new serious of Chicken Soup for the Teenage Soul publications. These books should be on every parent/grandparents required reading list for their loved ones. Should get 10 stars.
