

I could not really warm up to her, to me she seemed to be a spoiled little Girl and didn't care of the consequences of her actions. I am looking forward to the story of Jake and all the other books to come in the series. Keira Montclair is one of my favored Authors and Lily is the only book I was not a 100 % happy with. I loved reading about all the other characters of the Ramsey family from earlier books in Lily.

This story is funny and sweet and has some great twists and turns. If you haven't read any of Keira Montclair's books about the Grants and the Ramsey's you have missed out. They are all awesome and as you read you feel like part of the family. This family is large but full of love and support. The men are men, strong and powerful but can be brought to their knees by these women they love. All of Keira Montclair's books are stand alone reads, but I would recommend that you read all of them, if you don't you miss our on some great characters. I can't wait until the next book!

The characters, dialogue, and overall writing style of this book were so poor I couldn't even finish it. Lily's childlike innocence and naive nature are so at odds with anything sexual that it feels wrong even reading about it - besides the fact that her absolute lack of a grasp on reality is terribly annoying. Pair that with a flimsy plot and underdeveloped characters and interactions, I would not recommend this book to anyone, even for a "fun" read.
