

All of this may seem fantastic and perhaps exaggerated. But I checked out his footnotes/websites and when the references were found, there was credible back-up, often multiple sources. This should be a wake-up call to much that is wrong with America today. The economic playing table has been tilted to big businesses and the rich increasingly for 4-5 decades now. Corporate Conspiracies reveals the corporate oligarchy that has co-opted American democracy. It covers a wide range of corruption and crimes, such as those of Big Pharma, Big Energy, Big Banks, and the environmental wreckage of companies like Monsanto, as well as the purchase of political influence in Washington. It also covers important ground in lesser known crime scenes, such as 9/11, the mainstream crucifixion of whistleblower Edward Snowden, and the inherent dangers in the collection and sale of our private information by companies like Facebook and Google.
