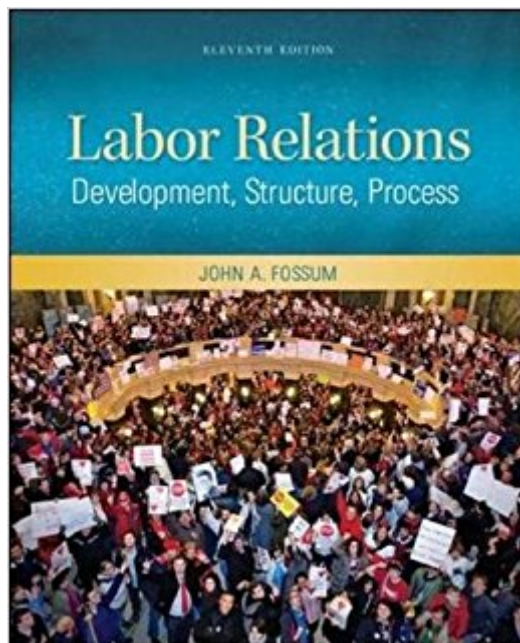

John Fossum received his PhD from Michigan State University. He is an established author in the labor relations/personnel area. He is currently a full professor and the director of the Industrial Relations Center at the University of Minnesota.

Many people who have used this book in a class said it was a good introductory book but it was a very underwhelming read. I was not a big fan of this textbook because of how it was written. Information that was covered in the text was not as detailed as I would have liked. Many times I felt that I had to do my own research to better understand the basics of the topic I had read about in a chapter. It got to the point where reading the chapters became an unpleasant chore but I kept reading knowing it would soon be over. I regret reading this textbook and would not have chosen to

read it if it had not been mandated reading for my university's course. All I can say is I can see why a new edition has been published. Hopefully it is better written in the newer version.

The author really spent a lot of time researching the book, and it appeared to be pretty unbiased. I would not get all my labor history, and how it works all just from this book though! Another book I would recommend for that is "They're Bankrupting Us!" And 20 Other Myths about Unions ~ by Bill Fletcher Jr.
