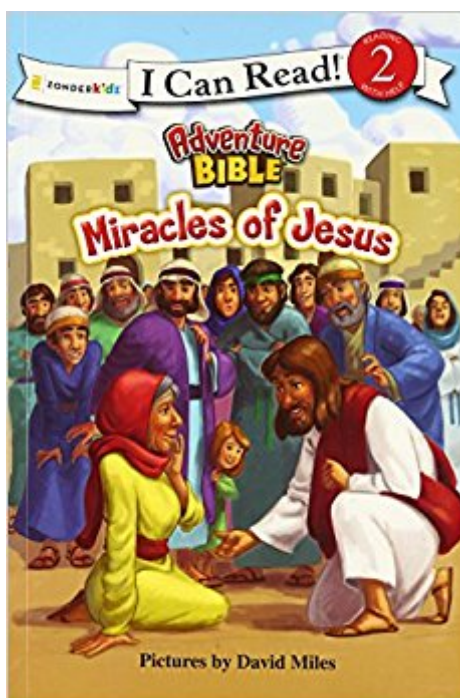

Books for children on the bible flood the market today. Every aspect of the Scriptures have been dissected and broken down in easy bite-sized sections for the young reader. For a little over 5 years

now my children have loved reading the stories that Zondervan has produced in their I Can Read Series. The current volume my children are digesting are the stories of the Miracles of Jesus. The layout and illustrations are familiar to me and my kids as we work our way through the life of Jesus. My daughter breezes through wondering what's next but my son is still in that stage where he wants to know everything about the stories. Who is that woman? Why is she on the ground? Why does Jesus have long hair? The Adventure Bible makes these questions a little easier to answer with engaging illustrations and an easy to follow story line. The colors are bright and eye-catching which keeps my son interested, even if for now he does ignore the dialogue. As a young Christian the NIV was where my faith lived. I've moved on to other translations since then but my kids love NIV stories at their level. I'm glad there's a long-standing tradition in these children's stories that Zondervan and the NIV have produced which stick with my kids even after they've graduated from them. My kids are able to read these on their own and follow along in a manner that suits them best. Zondervan keeps producing engaging children's stories and I think my kids are better off for it.

Zonderkidz' Adventure Bible I Can Read series is based on the Adventure Bible and illustrated by David Miles. "Miracles of Jesus" tells about some of the miracles of Jesus. It has two chapters. The first tells the story of Jairus' Daughter. This also included the part of the story where the woman touches Jesus' robe. I found it to be Biblically accurate. The other chapter tells of the Feeding of the 5000. It also followed the true story in the Bible. I am glad for stories that I can let my children read and know that it is teaching truth. It is a Level 2 reader which stands for "Reading with Help-high interest stories for developing readers". The illustrations were beautiful and reminded me of colored pencil pictures. Many of the pages are completely covered with color making the book visually appealing. At the end of the book is a "Did you Know?" section that lists some more of the miracles Jesus performs and a "Words to Treasure" section that gives a Bible verse. I would recommend this book for those with young children in their lives. I received a free copy of this book from Zonderkidz' zblogsquad in exchange for my honest review. All opinions are my own.

Miracles of Jesus is part of the Adventure Bible series. This book retells a few of the favorite Biblical stories about the miracles performed by Jesus. The writing is at a level 2 for children. I had my 8 year old daughter read this on her own and she said she liked it. Each page only has one to two sentences on it, with accompanying pictures that show what is going on in the story. What I liked the most was the trivia in the "Did you know?" section at the end of the book. I feel like this provides a

good challenge and inspiration for kids to go directly to the source and read more. Again, like the other books in this series, I thought the illustrations were a bit strange - oversized heads on the people, for example. I think this book could also use some help with pronouncing unfamiliar words and names, such as Jairus. 32 ZonderKidz's Adventure Bible reading series is a welcomed sight in my house. My children recognize the books and thoroughly enjoy looking through the Biblical stories. Miracles of Jesus is quite unlike the previous volumes reviewed because it does not have a stable storyline but consists of multiple short renditions of Christ's miracles. Miracles of Jesus covers Jairus's daughter, the long-suffering woman, and the feeding of the five thousand. These miracles do not share a common theme or story development. They are simply a representation of our Lord's miracles. While this is substantially different from previous works by David Miles, my kids loved the different scenes and stories. Though they admittedly cannot read the words of the book (being 3 yrs and 2 yrs), both have thoroughly enjoyed sitting down and retelling the stories to each other. Some in the Reformed Tradition will be turned off by depictions of Jesus. But there is nothing cut out from the Biblical text. Jairus's daughter is raised, the sick woman is truly timid, and the disciples doubt Christ's ability to feed everyone. For a small little book for children this presents itself as a solid depiction of Christ's miracles. In conclusion, Miracles of Jesus is a good little book for kids. While the story itself is inferior to other portions of the Adventure Bible I Can Read! Series, it remains part of a valuable and appreciated addition to our library.
