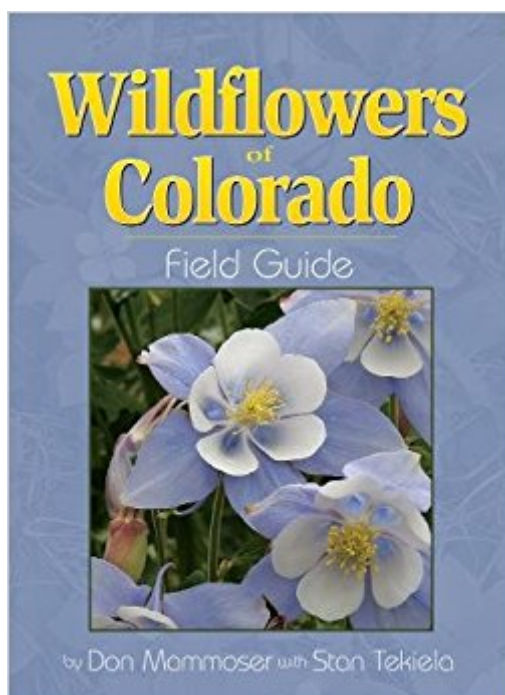

I like the way this guide is organized by flower color. No, it does not have every single wildflower growing in Colorado, but it has a very wide selection and is all that the average hiker needs to identify most flowers.

This little field guide is perfect for carrying in a backpack. It is small and light, but is jam packed with lots of detail about the individual flowers. The actual colored pictures make it easy to identify the flowers. It also helps that the flowers are separated by color.

Just moved to Colorado so I'm learning the flowers and really am enjoying this book. I like how it's organized and although some criticized that it did not cover all the flowers (does cover the most common ones), for a person just getting to know the flowers of CO, it is perfect. Small enough to tuck in my hiking pocket.

Grouping by color makes it easy to identify flowers, and having a small book that can be carried while you hike is convenient.
