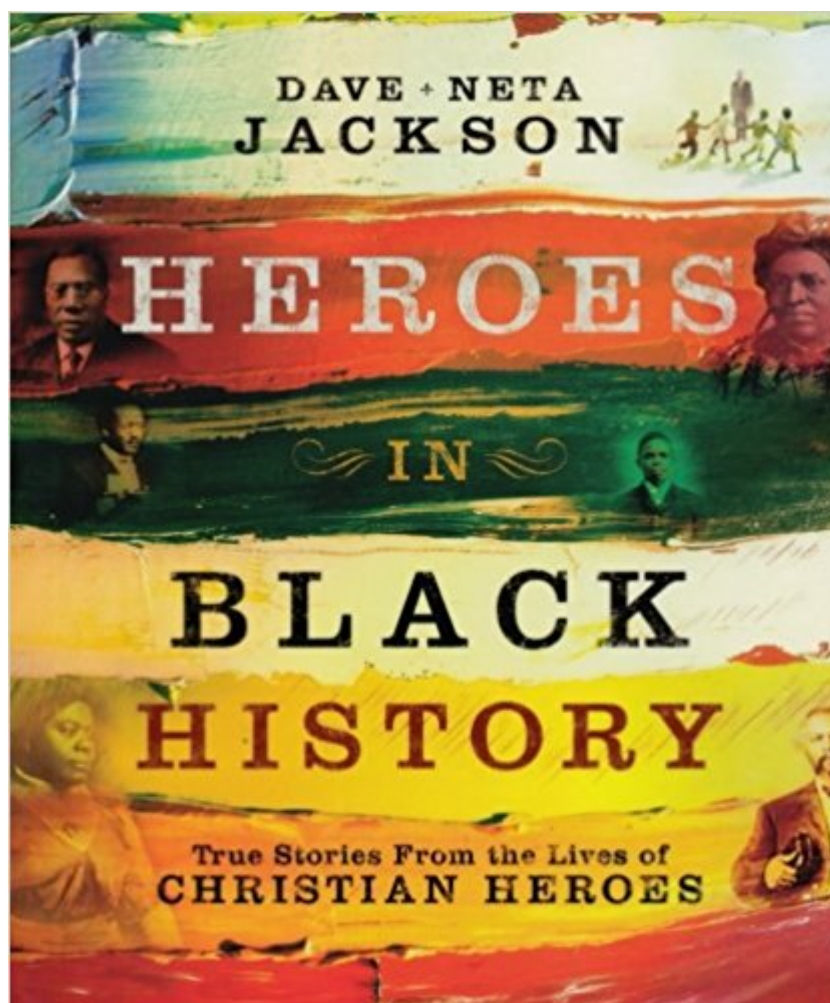

Dave and Neta Jackson are an award winning husband and wife writing team, the authors or coauthors of more than a hundred books. They are most well known for the Trailblazers, a forty book series of historical fiction about great Christian heroes for young readers (with sales topping 1.7 million) and Neta's popular Yada Yada Prayer Group novels for women. The Jacksons make their home in the Chicago metropolitan area, where they are active in cross cultural ministry and enjoy their grand children.

This is a very well written book that it is segmented in such away to make it quite easy for teaching small children as well as adults. My children are very much engrossed in it as we read a segment on each hero daily. The questions and scripture verses at the end are very helpful. Children can

capture the essence of each story very easily. It is interesting to note how little information is out there for children on Christian heroes from various cultures and indeed Nations. I would like to see more books like this, but more extensive for further study. I would also like to see on Christian Heroes from Asian, Latino cultures etc as well. There is so much that is lost when we miss the encouraging biographies of Christian believers from all over the world.

In "Heroes in Black History," co-authors Dave and Neta Jackson take from their forty-book Trailblazers series fourteen hall of faith African American heroes. Appropriate for children of all races from ages six-to-twelve, "Heroes" provides historical fiction in summary form. Each of the fourteen stories also includes a discussion guide with application for today. While written for young children, parents will find the book helpful for imparting life lessons from the legacy of African American Christianity.
