Good overview of Crete, recommendations of things to do, maps and links to Google maps. Nice e-book to have with you when you are planning your trip and to also have with you when you are in Crete. Well worth the money.

I liked this guide decently well. I can say that it's a bit large to carry, but I found it a great supplement to the Frommers guide. I just prefer a more organized daily plan with personal observations. There were great insights, but I thought there was almost too much information to process. Plus I prefer leaving a majority of the history to the tour, but I did find that helpful at points. I think the driving trips were great. The insight into local and regional traditions was helpful. The binding fell apart which was annoying to carry. Again the Frommers guide was a travel friendly size, it was laminated and it could take a beating in a backpack. This guide was more of a manual.
