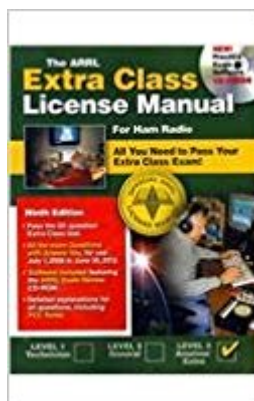

I ordered this license review as part of my preparation for the extra-class exam It arrived on time as I paid for express shipping. The only problem was the book was out of date when I got it! The exam set expired 4 days before I got the copy! It turned out to not matter. I took the exam on July 14 and missed one question in 50 which would be an excellent score. I was denied the license because the examining station only had the old test. So it turned out that it did not matter that my review manual was shipped out of date. The extra class test has a published pool of 800 questions. The manual itself was well written and it is annotated for the questions. In many ways this is a better review than hamtestonline.com because the ARRL book is the right depth for preparation for the exam. The internet site will get you ready for the exam quicker, however. I recommend a combination of the two. Read the ARRL book first then spend 2-3 weeks on the internet site. When I retake my 'failed' exam in a couple of months I'll get the up to date version. It is good for 3 years. I recommend it and most of the other ARRL books that I've bought over the years.

This is no light weight study guide; it is comprehensive on those topics covered by the Extra Class License exam. One of the features I like the best is that this license manual serves well as a

reference book long after the exam is over. Another plus is the included CD containing practice exam software. Concerning the software, it is also a minus on the following point - ARRL needs to recognize that many hams prefer and use Mac computers and would therefore make a Mac version of the software. Another very important feature is this manual contains the complete exam question pool - 738 question - all indexed and cross-referenced to the text covering the exam question topic. I use qrz.com for doing the practice tests, and when I miss a question, I can easily find the topic in the manual and clear up any confusion I may have over the "correct" answer. I have a growing collection of books and manuals published by ARRL. They are quality books both in physical construction and certainly in content.

Outdated, as I knew it would be, but still a great help in passing my Amateur Extra exam.

Fast shipping, packaged great, book was in like new condition and included CD-Rom was in great shape too. With this study guide, CD Rom and the online practice exams I should have no problem passing the extra class exam. Might take longer than the tech and general but I'll get it.

Great study guide. Make sure you get the current manual. These update every couple of years.

This book was very helpful and I still refer to it.

The ARRL Extra Class License Manual with CD-ROM could have never passed my Amateur Extra test without this book. It was both well written and well organized. Although the chapters did not exactly follow the layout of the test questions, all questions were covered and all answers explained. The included CD with all of the test pool questions is an invaluable aid for taking practice tests and offers many review options. The book arrived Thursday evening and I took my test Saturday morning, 8 days later. There were no surprise questions on the test and I passed with no problems. 73, Bill AE7OX

Like the General Review book this book has the questions, a short explanation, and a CD testing ROM that lets you learn all 750 questions. It's interactive, it's memory rote memorization, but it DOES work. I ordered the General Class book from the ARRL and they screwed around for almost a week before shipping. I go to .com, paid 9 dollars less, and got the book in 4 days - the ARRL may have written it, but it took them almost 4 days and 2 emails before I got a response. Good Luck for those
