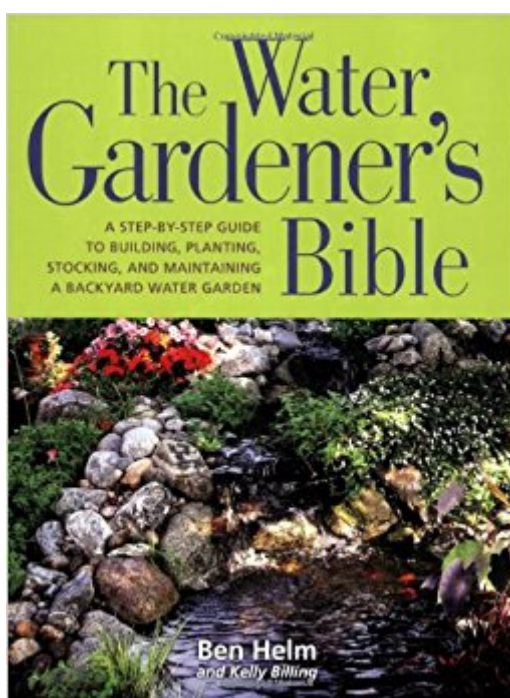

This is a must have book if you are serious about a garden pond. It has basic information about building a pond, but it really shines with its information about plants, fish, maintenance, and the ecology of how to have a balanced pond. I bought a few books while researching building ponds, and this is the best book by far.

a little British, e.g. in choosing which fish to describe, but overall excellent coverage of the "mechanics" of designing and building a pond. includes hardiness maps for Europe and much of the English-speaking world. somewhat redundant, in that related information is presented in several places instead of being collected together. for example, there is a generic chapter in the beginning called "Stocking plants and fish," and later an excellent reference section (about 20% of the book) which is allocated to descriptions of many pond, marginal, and bog plants
