

Primarily a collector's identification guide, this book contains a wealth of background information on the history of leading bear manufacturers and hundreds of photographs of the bears they produce. Among the German firms included are Steiff, Hermann, Schuco and Bing. American companies encompass Ideal, Dakin, Gund and Applause. Merrythought, Farnell, Chad Valley, Deans and Canterbury are some of the British manufacturers discussed. Mrs. Mullins explains how the social climate at the beginning of the 20th century was ripe for the development of the teddy bear. After the industrial revolution, for the first time the average person had some time for leisure. Time for such light-hearted interests plus the ease of communication helped spread the popularity of teddies. Named after President Theodore Roosevelt, the teddy bear was inspired by a political cartoon drawn by William Berryman. From this historic beginning, the story of the teddy is expanded by Mrs. Mullins to include photographs and descriptions of mechanical, musical and battery-operated bears. The book also contains chapters on artists bears, on how to display bears and of other soft toys such as the Golliwog and Billy Possum. Bear postcards, book and other related items are shown in fascinating array. This book has something to interest everyone!

There is a wealth of information for the teddy bear collector in this book. The book has many color photographs so wonderful some would be suitable for framing. Though published in the 1980's, it is still relevant to today's collector of teddy bears.

Linda Mullins identification book is a must for the teddy bear collector. I have followed Mullins' teddy bear shows in So. California for almost 20 years and this book captures the knowledge and experience of Mullins.
