

I am savoring this book. Each time I dip into it, I learn something I can use in preparing a sermon, and I've been at it since seminary 40+ years ago. More importantly, each sermon is a joy to read, opening up new ways of looking at the texts that inform one's life, not just one's preaching. One caveat: don't begin reading the essays in this volume when you are in the midst of preparing a sermon because you may find you want to start over! As a disclaimer, I was sent a review copy, but when I came to the page on to order a copy for a friend and saw no one had yet reviewed it I realized a word here was definitely called for.
