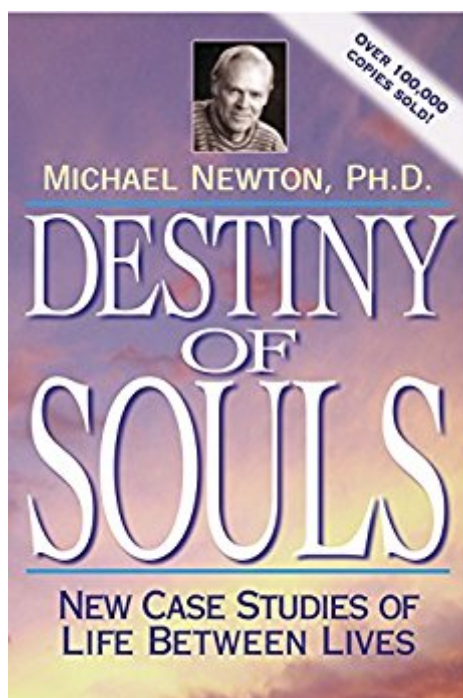

Of all the studies of lives between lives, I must say Dr. Newton is the master. He's done over 7,000 regressions, which tells me what he says is not a fluke. Other hypnotists specializing in this field report similar results. It would have been nice to see if similar results had been obtained from similar regression in other countries and cultures. My strong feeling is they would agree with what Dr. Newton presents in his book. He writes very clearly and is extremely organized. Because of my scientific bent, I enjoyed his organization of the material. It's not that easy of a read, but well worth the time. I would strongly recommend you read his earlier book "Journey of Souls" first, as "Destiny of Souls" is the second in the series. However, it can stand on its own. If you want more detail on what really goes on with past lives, reincarnation and the spirit world, Dr. Newton is the best! I constantly re-read this book for inspiration. I use this as my "Bible." I speak from experience, as I had a LBL regression a few years ago by a hypnotist trained by Dr. Michael Newton. She had done hundreds of these regressions, so I felt I was getting the "real deal." Even though I was familiar with his work, I still had some amazing revelations in store during my regression. They confirmed other information I received from physics over many years. I am a "blue light" (an "advanced soul") and amazingly sat for a brief while with my "council." That was mind blowing. I got my "soul name" and met all the members of my "soul group." In summary, I can't speak too highly of this book and Dr. Newton's research. If you have any interest in reincarnation, this is a must read.
