

(1)There is seriously no time to whip out a textbook every night managing ICU patients when you start out. (2) When speaking to my attendings, even when I was wrong, my application was sound, and to me that's a huge point with the attendings and medicine overall. Residency is a learning experience, the more you man up justifying your reasoning with conceptual thinking, everyone considers it, more than belting out facts. The Book helped immensely in "thinking it out" on the fly. The way it is written is very conceptual. Honestly, there is no time to be relying on anything but "muscle memory."
