

Meade Breeze is a Florida boat bum living on a trawler. He has a habit of attracting sexy women, some good, but many not so good. He is skilled at both boat handling and getting into and out of trouble of the legal and feminine kind. All of Ed Roninsons's "Trawler Trash" series are quick reads.

As a land locked former boat bum, Ed Robinson has the ability to take me back to some of the best times of my life with every turn of the page. Ed's latest work Cool Breeze reminds this reader of John D MacDonald, a delightful mix of adventure and a deep understanding and care for the environmental ills facing Florida. Another great read from an author who this reader has come to thoroughly enjoy and admire.

Including Cool Breeze, I have now read the last three books in the Meade Breeze series. I have enjoyed all three, and I am looking forward to what comes next for Breeze. Meade Breeze reminds me of Travis McGee. Both live on a boat in Florida. Both live on the edge of society. Just like McGee, Breeze does a lot of thinking. He has regrets and nightmares.
