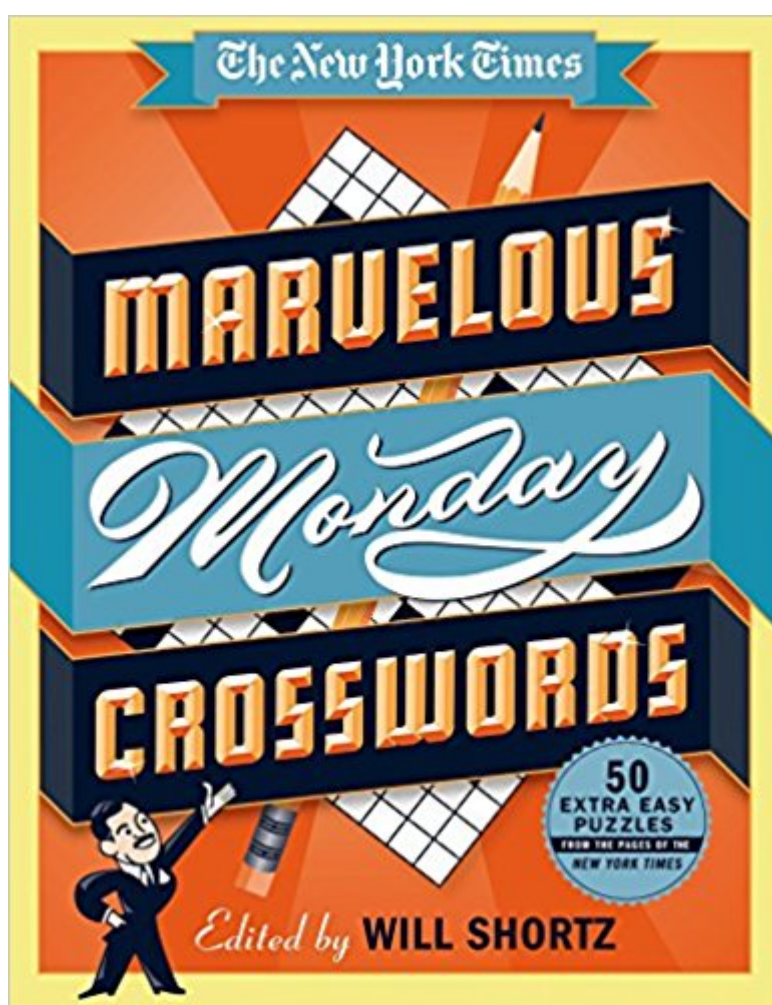

Will Shortz has been the crossword puzzle editor of The New York Times since 1993. Mr. Shortz founded both the American Crossword Puzzle Tournament, where he serves as director, and the World Puzzle Championship, where he is the captain of the U.S. team. He is the current Puzzlemaster for "Weekend Edition Sunday" on National Public Radio.

It promises to be easy, and it is ... but with just the right amount of challenge. The puzzles were largely solvable, but I had to really massage connecting words to get some answers. And I had several puzzles where I flubbed a couple of solutions anyway. I have a very good vocabulary and am reasonably well read, so I'm surprised that I did have to work at these a bit. I have never really

done crosswords before, and I got this because I wanted to ease in and learn the tricks. This was good for that. Another aspect I am appreciating now that I have moved on to Tuesdays: this one does not rely so much on knowledge of recent pop culture and sports figures (things I will just never solve unless I can get all connectors, and even then, I still might not know). Finally, I needed something for my brain to focus on but which did not create a lot of frustration and anxiety, and this fit that bill very well.
