

Sears, Roebuck & Co. was founded in 1886 in Chicago, Illinois. It published a general merchandise mail order catalog and consumer guide from 1888 until 1993. It is the author of the 1897 Sears Roebuck & Co. Catalogue and the 1908 Sears, Roebuck & Co. Catalogue.

I purchased this item for some research into hardware items available to the settlers of the frontier West. It was a very entertaining catalogue in that it shows clothing styles and accessories as well. I was amazed at the number of pages that were dedicated to jewelry, watches, buttons and "notions" as they were called. The prices of items were also a fun realization.
