

Major problem with the digital version of this book. Many of the paragraphs in the text are truncated and missing letters or words at the end. You can infer some of the content, but not always. This is a critical issue for a book being used for a college class!

The book has an abundant set of cases from which we can supplement our course discussions with Dr. Patanakul. The kindle book layout could be improved for better navigation and readablility. But the content of the book is excellent -- derived from real-world examples, and rich with stories that provide insights,

What the book fails to mention is that you need the PMBOK too, otherwise, you have no idea how to answer the questions at the end of each case study.

While the questions at the end of each section make you think about what you've read, I dislike the fact that most are based in opinion, and there is no concrete anything in this book. This is required for two of my project management classes, and I've disliked its use in both. Each section relates something that is most likely going wrong or mismanaged, and then asks questions that relate to what you just read. However, the sections are told in a conversational manner, as if you were a fly on the wall or sitting down to coffee and overhearing a conversation across the way. There is no concrete information on which to base your answers to the questions - its all up for interpretation and makes you feel as if you are grasping for straws. Were I a teacher, I would steer clear of this book and favor one with more concrete empirical examples which could be analyzed and proven

rather than read like a tabloid article.
