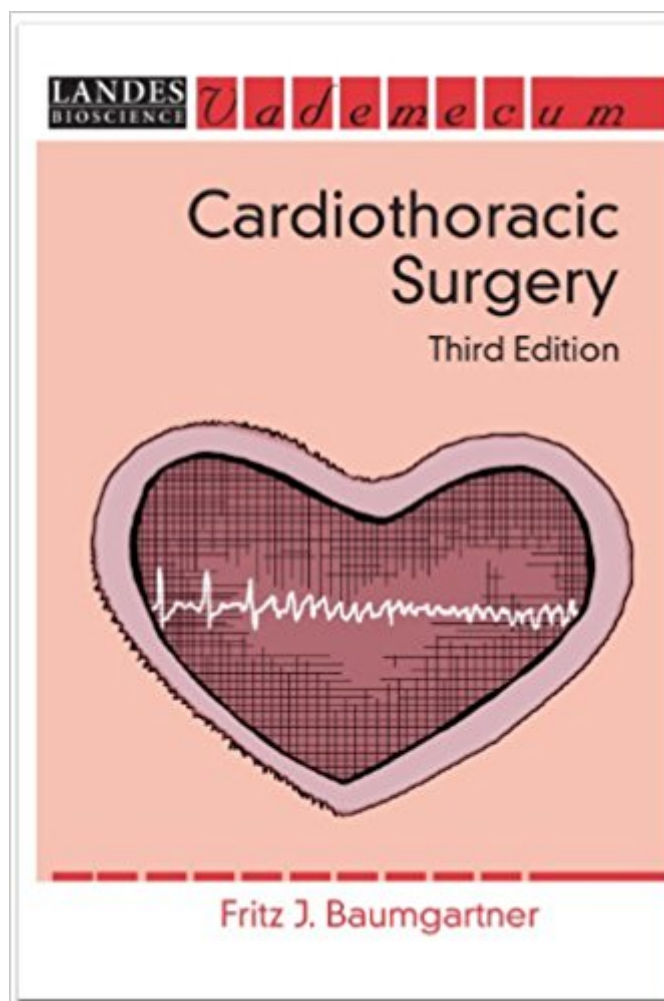

Written primarily for surgery residents at any level of training, this handbook emphasizes applied pathophysical, indication for medical versus surgical intervention and the detailed surgical techniques used at the Division of Cardiothoracic Surgery at Harbor-UCLA.
