

This is an account of a little known epidemic, encephalitis lethargica, that has occurred several times in our history but seems to have been forgotten. Ms Crosby is a thorough researcher and a very good writer making somewhat dull information come alive.

In 2014, when we know the answers to so many medical/biologic mysteries of our past, this one remains unsolved. The book reads like a novel: easy to understand, and spellbinding.

What if you couldn't really wake up. This epidemic of sleeping sickness is hardly heard of, but it affected and killed dozens of people less than a century ago. Very enlightening and well written.
