I bought this book on recommendation from a friend when I began planning a trip to Ukraine. I usually dread picking up a travel guide, feeling overwhelmed by too much information, but this one has been a pleasant read. Ashley Hardaway writes with a bit of humor and complete honesty. She provides the kind of knowledge beyond tourist attractions that only someone with her experience and attitude can provide. I have had my copy for a week and already it is covered in notes, highlighting and earmarked pages. Ashley's book has been a great tool for planning our trip, which we couldn't be more excited about. She has provided a lot of great tips and insider information for questions I didn't know to ask. This isn't a book full of shiny advertisements of places to visit in Ukraine, it's an honest interpretation of actual experience that has left me feeling confident about our upcoming travels.

This book was, in general, a good read. The writer did provide useful information about locations and places to see, stay & eat throughout the book. However, this book was never proofread before being released and there are not only many grammatical errors, but also some geographical ones as well. (For example, Poltava IS NOT located west of Kiev...it is located east of Kiev.) It is a handy book for someone planning any kind of extensive or frequent visits to Ukraine. From my own travels to Ukraine, there are a few things that I would debate with the author about, but all in all, I think he did a good job. I just wished he had covered more of the Donbas region and also more on Kharkiv.

Informative, yet quirky at times. As someone who's spent time in the "Soviet-bloc", I could appreciate the level of humor when describing the country's culture and transition from the communist umbrella. Hardaway also did a great job of distancing herself from the Lonely Planet series, adding colorful backgrounds to locales and a thoughtful approach to everyday life that could only come from a person who lived in the region.

It's absolutely awesome. The way the places are described make them even more attractive than they actually are. It's like a fiction and I enjoy reading every word. Probably the best travelbook I have ever had. Thank you, Dearest Liaison!
