Synopsis

I expected a little more help from the other heroes. Other than that it was a great book.

First off let me start by saying I love Natasha Romanoff and I will buy anything that she's in. Okay so this book is super action packed but not so much that I can't follow the story (which was a problem I had in the first one) Ava's arc throughout the book was really interesting to see as well as Nat's. I like how it tied together their two stories and also included some of the MCU characters that I love so much. Also CAROL DANVERS aka Captain Marvel (kinda spoiler-ish I think) was in this so it pretty much gets an A+ from me. Anyways I really hope this gets a sequel and possibly gets us a Black Widow movie.

Ava and Natasha, the red and black widow respectively, are still tied to one another.
