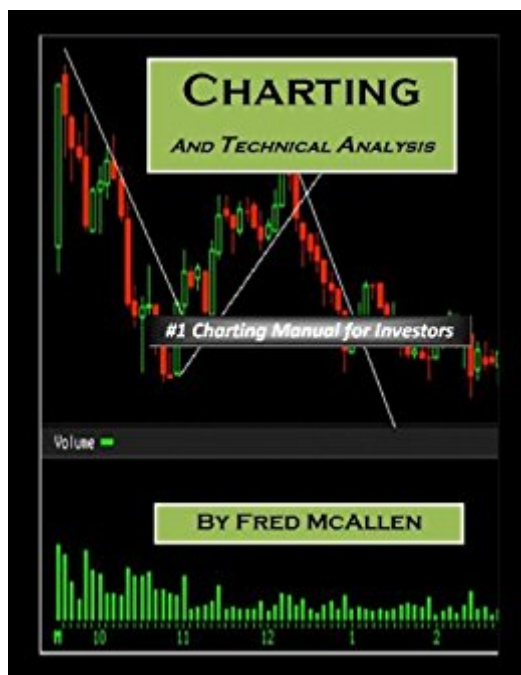

Immediately after I finished reading this, I went back through the high points to make sure I have the candlestick patterns and major icons down to memory. The book goes in depth when explaining Dow Theory, Candlesticks, MAs, trending, volume and examples through out of each. He also covers in detail how to use technicals to choose entry and exit points. After reading this book, you should have no problem using technicals to spot trends, tops, bottoms, and the direction of a stock. The book is well written and very easy to understand, with just a few minimal oversights. One of the greatest values of this book is the attention to minimizing loses. Had I read this book a long time ago, I would not have rode stocks to the bottom, or jumped in a stock "thinking" the bottom had formed. By that same token, it would have been a lot easier to have spotted the top and locked in profits. This and "Getting Started With Value Investing" by Charles Mizrah should be part of any investors collection, especially those new to investing. The author goes into great detail explaining the most popular technicals and charts, while just going over in brief things like the MACD, stochastics, and bollinger bands. In the trading I do, I often use what is covered in this book, MACDs, and the RSI charts, and I have done pretty well.
