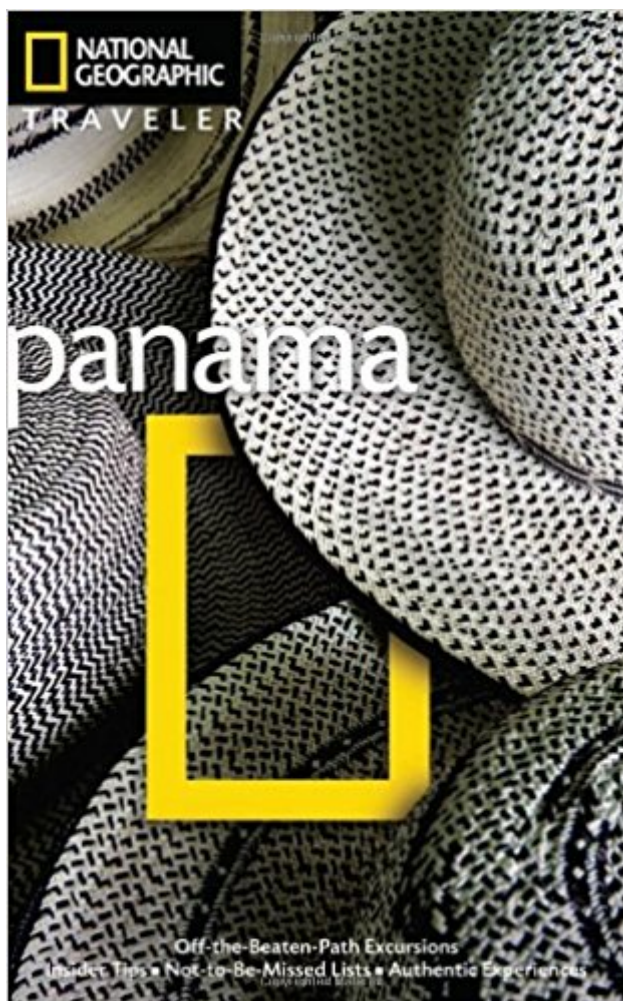

This book is as pretty on the inside as it is on the cover, with thick glossy paper, colorful photos and an interesting layout. Unfortunately it's a little glossy in its content too. If you want an overview of the main points of interest in Panama, or are looking for a book to convince that special someone that Panama's worth a trip, this is the perfect book for you. If you're looking for nitty-gritty, detailed insight on almost anything you might want to know to actually travel around this country, take a look at Moon Panama. Warning: The font is very small and hard to read; if I didn't have young eyes I'm not sure I could have managed it.

Panama is a beautiful country. On the other hand, most countries are beautiful. This book captures the beauty of Panama with exquisite photographs. The colors are ever so vivid. One wonders how many thousand pictures were taken for this collection and how these were ultimately selected. Nevertheless, they are excellent choices. The text is not overly sophisticated but National Geographic picture books are just that -- visual, pictorial representations. It is not a travel log or a guidebook, it is a beautiful visual introduction to an interesting country. Maybe you will be enticed to visit.
