

Without being a standout, this has all the essentials that you would expect in a basic phrasebook: pronunciation and grammar guides, phrases organised by category (greetings, ordering food & drink, transport, etc), Malay equivalents and a handy glossary at the end (all searchable for kindle users). My only quibble with the kindle version is that some of the table formats did not conver properly, making some entries a little confusing or just less easy to read. I would recommend this to travellers seeking a basic phrasebook. You may also like to consider "Instant Indonesian: How to express 1,0000 different ideas with just 100 key words and phrases", which takes a somewhat different, and quite clever, approach to the introductory phrasebook.
