Isamu Noguchi: Playscapes





Synopsis

In 1933, the visionary sculptor Isamu Noguchi (1904â⠬⠜88) began making design proposals for children \tilde{A} \hat{a}_{a} , \hat{c}_{s} playgrounds in New York. The first one, Play Mountain (1933), marked the beginning of the artist $\hat{A}\phi \hat{a} - \hat{a}_{\mu}\phi s$ fascination with exploring points of intersection between sculpture, public spaces and, above all, play. Radically experimental in its approach to children $\hat{A}\phi\hat{a} - \hat{a}_{\mu}\phi s$ recreation, the design asserted, with no apparent precedent, that children $\tilde{A}\phi \hat{a} - \hat{a}_{,,\phi} \hat{c}s$ exercise and entertainment could be stimulated by simply providing earth modulations and steps for running, jumping and sliding. Noguchi \hat{A} ¢ $\hat{a} \neg \hat{a}_{\mu}$ ¢s playground was a spectacular innovation of design, and something never before seen in New York Cityââ \neg â, ¢s brief 32-year history of building and operating playgrounds. But Play Mountain also initiated a lengthy period of frustrated endeavor, in which Noguchi only saw one of his park designs become a reality. This changed in the 1970s, when public space policies began to favor artists $\tilde{A}\phi \hat{a} \neg \hat{a}_{\mu}\phi$ participation in project design. Since then, Noguchi \tilde{A} ¢ $\hat{a} \neg \hat{a}_{\mu}$ ¢s pioneering playgrounds have become a touchstone for the revival of interest in the golden era of playground design. This is the first volume to bring together all of the artist $\hat{A}\phi\hat{a} - \hat{a}_{,,\phi}\phi$ s investigations into playgrounds over a period of 50 years. It reproduces his beautiful scale models, sketches and photographs of iconic designs, highlighting a little-known facet of one of the most versatile sculptors of the 20th century.
