

This book is pre-cut friendly showing you how to use fat quarters, jelly rolls, layer cakes and charm squares as well as yardage. Tips show you how to mix and match blocks or change block size, easy cut and sew. It is the ultimate no-maths reference for quilters. All the calculating is done for you. If I were just rating the information in the "book" I would have given it a 4+ but I really hate the Kindle version because it is so difficult to get to the individual blocks. In order to find each block you have to scroll through the whole book page by page until you find the one you want. I had expected to be able to "link" through to the block by tapping the block number which is accented in a similar blue as a hyperlink. It is not user friendly and I wish I had just found a print version to buy.

I love this reference tool. I highly recommend it for beginners and the "I've been doing this awhile" folks. I intend to order a few to give as gifts to my quilters in the family.
